

How to Reach **Aston University** from London or **Upon Arrival** in the UK

For international delegates arriving in the United Kingdom, Birmingham is easily accessible from major entry points like London Heathrow Airport, Gatwick Airport, and Birmingham International Airport.

From London Heathrow Airport (LHR):

- Take the Heathrow Express to London Paddington Station (15 min).
- Transfer to the London Underground (Circle Line) to Euston Station (10 min).
- Board a direct train from London Euston to Birmingham New Street (1h 20 min).
- Upon arrival at Birmingham New Street Station, Aston University is a 15-minute walk or a short taxi ride.

From Birmingham International Airport (BHX)

- Take the Air-Rail Link to Birmingham International Train Station (2 min).
- Board a direct train to Birmingham New Street Station (10 min).
- Aston University is a 15-minute walk or short taxi ride.



Alternative Transport Options

- Coaches: National Express and Megabus offer affordable coach services from Heathrow, Gatwick, and Manchester Airports to Birmingham Coach Station.
- Taxis & Ride-Hailing: Uber, Bolt, and local taxis are available from all major UK airports.
- Car Rentals: Available at all major airports for those preferring self-drive.
